We also talked about boats and bridges. The children made a boat out of play dough as well as aluminum foil. Ask them if their boat was able to float or if it sank to the bottom. Some children put marble in their boat to see how many it would hold until it sank. One boat held 69 marbles.

The children got to explore pumpkins. They got to pull out the pulp from the pumpkin and count the seeds. We guessed which pumpkin that they thought would have more seeds. There was a small, medium and large pumpkin. We also roasted the pumpkin seeds. Ask your child if they liked the pumpkin seeds that we made.
